

RESOLUTION NO. 12-2010

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF INLAND WATERS POLLUTION CONTROL, INC. FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE WHITE PINE DRIVE CULVERT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has received a letter from its Consulting Engineer, ARCADIS U.S., Inc. enclosing a proposed repair to the headwall at the 54" culvert at White Pine Drive and to perform culvert repair using Cured-in-Place liner at the separated culvert pipe in the amount of \$24,941.00 from Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Consulting Engineer recommends acceptance of this bid on an emergency basis to provide emergency repair to the damaged pipe and headwall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to accept the bid of Inland Waters Pollution Control, Inc. in the amount of \$24,941.00 to provide emergency repair to the damaged pipe and headwall at the culvert on White Pine Drive in accordance with the recommendation letter from the Village's Consulting Engineer, ARCADIS U.S., Inc., on an emergency basis without the necessity of formal bidding and advertisement.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to repair the culvert and headwall as recommended by the Village's Consulting Engineer; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
