

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF U.S. TANKER - FIRE APPARATUS, INC. FOR SALE TO THE VILLAGE OF A NEW TANKER/PUMPER TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received by the Service Director on December 17, 1999 for sale to the Village of a new tanker/pumper; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended the acceptance of the bid of U.S. Tanker - Fire Apparatus, Inc. in the amount of \$205,252.00 as being the lowest and best bid in accordance with the memorandum dated January 14, 2000 attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of U.S. Tanker - Fire Apparatus, Inc. in the amount of \$205,252.00 for sale to the Village of a tanker/pumper, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted. Additionally, the equipment to meet the NFPA standard as set forth in the "B" bid is hereby accepted in the amount of \$9,799.00.

SECTION 2. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$215,051.00 from the Fire Truck Fund.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to obtain a discount on Bid "B"; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
