

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AFTER ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR TOWING OF VEHICLES THAT ARE JUNK, ABANDONED OR THAT OTHERWISE MUST BE REMOVED AT THE DIRECTION OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD FOR THE YEAR 2000-2001

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized, empowered and directed to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the towing of vehicles that are junk, abandoned or that otherwise must be removed at the direction of the Village of Richfield Police Department within the Village of Richfield for the year 2000-2001, to be in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Service Director. Said contract shall be entered into after advertising for not less than two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Richfield and awarded to the lowest and best bidder. The specifications on file in the office of the Service Director are hereby approved. The contract shall be in form approved by the Director of Law and shall be in conformance with such specifications. It shall be executed by the Mayor.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
