

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF LEE INFRASTRUCTURE RESTORATION, INC. FOR RESTORATION OF WET WELL NOS. 3, 4 AND 5 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Wet Well Nos. 3, 4 and 5 in Village's main sewer line in Brecksville Road are in need of rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, Lee Infrastructure Restoration, Inc. has a patented process to rehabilitate the wells; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has received a bid from Lee Infrastructure Restoration, Inc. in the amount of \$36,900.00 to rehabilitate the wells which she believes is fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Section 735.051.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members of Council elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Lee Infrastructure Restoration, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$36,900.00 to restore Wet Well Nos. 3, 4 and 5 on an emergency basis be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to rehabilitate needed wet wells at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Work to be performed at: 3 Wet Wells in Richfield

We hereby propose to furnish all the materials, equipment, and perform all the labor necessary for the completion of the restoration of 3 Wet Wells for the Village of Richfield.

1. All work will be completed to the Manufacturer's specifications. Raven Lining Systems, Tulsa, OK 800-324-2810
2. All materials used for restoration will be compatible as per manufacturers recommendations.
3. All safety measures will be strictly enforced by Lee I.R.. Gas meters, Tripods, safety lines and all other safety equipment for confined space entry will be on site. All employees are confined space entry trained. Ventilation will also be provided if needed.
4. The debris generated from the surface preparation will be caught so that it will not go down the sanitary line, to the best of our ability. Lee I.R. will dispose of all debris.
5. Aquatapoxy A-10 will be put on as a primer coat at approximately 10 mils. Aquatapoxy HB-1 will be put on as a mid coat at approximately 180 mils. Aquatapoxy A-6 will be put on as a corrosion barrier at approximately 60 mils. A total milage of approximately 250 mils.
6. A wet film test will be done at different intervals during the project to determine the milage.
After 7 days Lee I.R. will return and do approximately 6 pull tests to determine how well the coating adhered to the surface.
7. Work and material will be guaranteed for 3 years. All repairs will be done by Lee I.R. at no cost to the village.

All material, equipment, and labor is guaranteed to be as specified, and the above work to be performed in accordance with the drawings and specifications of the manufacturer .
All work will be completed in a substantial work-like manner.
Workmen's compensation and general liability insurance on above project will be the responsibility of Lee Infrastructure Restoration, Inc.

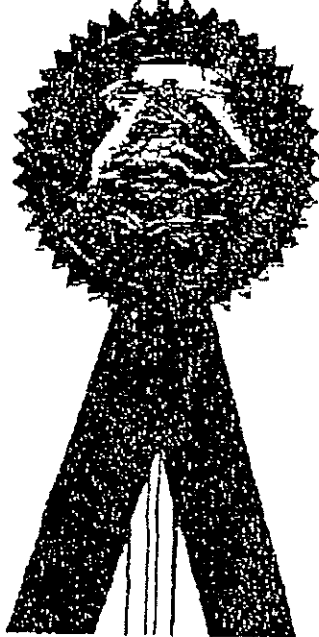
