**A RESOLUTION TO MAKE TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR
EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, STATE OF OHIO,
DURING THE FIRST QUARTER ENDING MARCH 31, 2010**

SECTION 1. To provide for expenditures of the Village of Richfield during the first quarter ending March 31, 2010 the following sums be, and they hereby are, set aside and appropriated as follows:

H) Water Revenue Fund	100,000.
I) Capital Improvement Fund	300,000.
J) Sanitary Sewer Fund	500,000.
K) Water Improvement Fund	20,000.
L) Brecksville Road Fund	150,000.
M) Land/Building Acquisition Fund	50,000.
N) Sewer Operations Fund	257,127.
O) Police Pension Fund	10,000.
P) Fire Pension Fund	10,000.
Q) Contractor Retainer Fund	30,000.

Section 4. In accordance with Section 4.12 of the Charter of the Village of Richfield, this Resolution No.71-2009 shall take effect and be in force upon the approval of the Mayor.
