

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF MAR-ZANE FOR ASPHALT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received by the Service Director from Mar-Zane for sale to the Village of asphalt in accordance with bid tabulation attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Mar-zane, 720 Home Avenue, Akron, Ohio 44310-4191, being the lowest and best bid in accordance with the bid tabulation attached hereto as Exhibit "A," be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to have materials for the summer construction season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
