

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE SAFETY BUILDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has engaged an architect to design a new Safety Building; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the construction of the new Safety Building are on file in the office of the Service Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of a new Safety Building in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file in her office.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to receive bids for a necessary municipal building at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
