

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A PETITION FOR ANNEXATION AS DULY SERVED AND INDICATING SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION TERRITORY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, by letter dated March 9, 1999, Harry A. Tipping, agent for Petitioners to annex approximately 196.29 acres in Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield notified the Village of Richfield that the Petition was filed with the Summit County Council by filing the same with the Clerk of the Summit County Council on March 5 and amended on March 8, 1999; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 709.01, a hearing has been scheduled for Monday, May 17, 1999; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 709.031, this Council wishes to acknowledge receipt of the Petition and to indicate the services to be provided to the territory proposed for annexation upon annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby acknowledges receipt of the Petition for Annexation of 196.29 acres in Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield, which Petition was filed with the Clerk of the Summit County Council on March 5 and amended on March 8, 1999.

SECTION 2. This Council hereby indicates that all Village services, including, but not limited to, police, fire, service and garbage will be provided to the territory proposed for annexation upon annexation.

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby declares its intent to accept dedication of the proposed annexation when presented pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.04.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason to be effective by the May 17, 1999 hearing before the Summit County Council; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immedi-

ately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


AFFIDAVIT OF JOSEPH STOPAK

I have reviewed the approximately 196.29 acres in question which has been requested to be annexed from Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield, Ohio.


Based upon the location and general area of the land in question, it is my professional opinion that the Village of Richfield can provide fire protection for said area after annexation is approved.




