A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRIBUTION TO THE AKRON/
SUMMIT COUNTY METRO PARKS FOR PLANNING PURPOSES FOR
PLANNING PHASE II OF THE COUNTY TRAIL NETWORK AND DECLAR-
ING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to make a contribution to Akron/Summit County Metro Parks for planning purposes for planning Phase II of the County Trail Network in the amount of \$5,000.00.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$5,000.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund for this purpose.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to plan for trails at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
