

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF NORCO EQUIPMENT CO., INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received on May 3, 1999 for sale to the Village of a high pressure breathing air compressor system; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director and Fire Chief have recommended acceptance of the bid of Norco Equipment Co., Inc. in the amount of \$28,922.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Norco Equipment Co., Inc. in the amount of \$28,922.00 be, and the same hereby is, accepted in accordance with the memorandum of the Service Director dated May 4, 1999, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. That there is hereby appropriated an additional \$4,000.00 from the Capital Improvement Fund for this purchase.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to insure the safety of the members of the Fire Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.






