

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE COLUMBIA ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Summit County, Richfield Township and the Village of Richfield have jointly applied for Issue 2 funds for the Columbia Road Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, Issue 2 funds have been approved for this Project; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to advertise for bids for this Project under the terms and conditions of the Issue 2 grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the Columbia Road Reconstruction Project in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file in his office.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to comply with the terms of the Issue 2 grant requirements; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
