

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF CROSS-ROADS ASPHALT RECYCLING FOR THE VILLAGE'S CHIP SEAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received on July 29, 1999 for the Village's chip seal improvement program; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended acceptance of the bid of Cross-Roads Asphalt Recycling as being the lowest and best bid in accordance with the bid tabulation attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Cross-Roads Asphalt Recycling in the amount of \$23,140.00 for the Village's chip seal improvement program, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to implement the 1999 chip seal program at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
