

RESOLUTION NO. 56-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH TELADOC HEALTH, INC. FOR PHYSICIAN SERVICES FOR FULL-TIME VILLAGE EMPLOYEES FOR AUGUST 1, 2021 THROUGH JULY 31, 2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village's insurance advisor, Associated Underwriters Insurance Inc. has recommended entering into an agreement with Teladoc Health, Inc. to be the provider of physician services for full-time Village employees from August 1, 2021 through July 31, 2022, and declaring an emergency.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Teladoc Health, Inc. effective August 1, 2021 not to exceed \$6.76 per employee per month or approximately \$5,111 per year in accordance with the offer from Teladoc, a copy of which offer is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference, subject to the final approval of the Law Director.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to comply with the timing requirements of the program; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Subject: FW: Village of Richfield 7/1 Teladoc Renewal

Village of Richfield currently has access to general medical, behavioral health, and dermatology at the rate of \$6.44. To renew the plan as is, they will see a book of business increase moving them to the new rate of \$6.76 effective 7/1. The copays associated with behavioral health and dermatology will also increase as well. I will lay out the new copay rates below.

- **Mental Health:** Members have on-going virtual visits with licensed psychiatrist, psychologist, or therapist of their choice
 - \$220/ \$100/ \$90 copays
- **Dermatology:** Virtual access to board certified dermatologist to diagnose, treat and prescribe on dermatological conditions
 - \$85 copay
