

RESOLUTION NO. 28-1997

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE A 1997 LIGHT TRANSIT VEHICLE THROUGH THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM OF THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1-1988, the Village of Richfield entered into the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Transportation of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has informed Council that the Village is in need of a new Senior Citizen Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Program has determined that such a vehicle would be available from Whitworth Bus Sales, Inc., Box 126, West Carrollton, Ohio 45449 at a cost of \$41,524.00 which the Service Director believes is fair and reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase a new 1997 light transit vehicle from Whitworth Bus Sales, Inc., Box 126, West Carrollton, Ohio 45449 at a cost of \$41,524.00 through the Ohio Department of Transportation State Cooperative Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the vehicle is immediately necessary for the functioning of the Village; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
