A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF W. G. LOCKHART CONSTRUCTION FOR CONTRACT A FOR THE EVERETT ROAD SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE 1 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received on June 14, 1996 for Contract A (pumping station, force main and sanitary sewers) of the Everett Road Sanitary Sewer Improvements, Phase 1; and

WHEREAS, the Consulting Engineer has recommended acceptance of the bid of W. G. Lockhart Construction in the amount of \$498,282.00 as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of W. G. Lockhart Construction in the amount of \$498,282.00, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted for Contract A, Everett Road Sanitary Sewer Improvements, Phase 1.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for healthful and sanitary conditions along Everett Road; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
