

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY DISTRICT 8 INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE FOR STATE ISSUE 2 ASSISTANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield has received notification of the availability of funds for capital improvement projects pursuant to Chapter 164 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield has committed local funds and investigated all other available sources of funding and has had plans and specifications prepared for the requested projects; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County District 8 Infrastructure Committee is now accepting applications for Issue 2 Program Year 11, LTIP Program Year 9 for funding requests through the State Infrastructure Bond Program and the Village of Richfield hereby requests funding approval; and

WHEREAS, the application deadline for District 8 is July 1, 1996.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to file an application on behalf of the Village of Richfield with the Summit County District 8 Infrastructure Committee for funds for Infrastructure for:

- (1) Sanitary Sewer Extension - Everett Road Phase II
- (2) Sanitary Sewer Extension - Farnham Road


SECTION 2. The Village of Richfield hereby agrees to abide by all rules and regulations of the Program with its funding requirements, and hereby commits to continual progress toward implementation of these improvement projects.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for sanitary conditions within the Village; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its

passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
