

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF 120.83 HOURS OF SICK TIME TO GLENN G. KRAMER

WHEREAS, Glenn G. Kramer retired on June 29, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Glenn G. Kramer was first hired on September 1, 1981 as a part-time Patrolman; and

WHEREAS, Glenn G. Kramer served a Juvenile Officer from September 1, 1985; and

WHEREAS, Glenn G. Kramer was hired as a full-time Patrol Officer on January 2, 1987 and was promoted to Sergeant on December 17, 1990; and

WHEREAS, Richfield Code Section 153.07(b) requires in order to receive payment for accumulated sick time the employee must serve 10 years full-time service; and

WHEREAS, this Council, in light of the extraordinary service and devotion that Glenn G. Kramer has rendered to the Village, wishes to waive the 10-year requirement inasmuch as Glenn Kramer was only six months short of the ten-year full time requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to pay Glenn G. Kramer 120.83 hours of accumulated sick time.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
