A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF EAGLE INTERNATIONAL TRUCK SALES, INC. FOR SALE TO THE VILLAGE OF A FIVE-TON DUMP TRUCK AND EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received by the Service Director for sale to the Village of a five-ton dump truck with equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended acceptance of the bid of Eagle International Truck Sales, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Eagle International Truck Sales, Inc., a copy of which bid is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference, be, and the same hereby is, accepted as the lowest and best bid.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary for this agreement to take effect as soon as possible; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
