**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF KOVACH MOBILE
EQUIPMENT CORP. (KME) FOR SALE OF A FIRE TRUCK TO THE
VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

Whereas, pursuant to advertisement, bids were received for sale of a fire truck to the Village; and

Whereas, the Fire Chief has recommended acceptance of the bid of Kovach Mobile Equipment Corp. (KME) as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Kovach Mobile Equipment Corp. (KME) in the amount of \$202,606.00 plus additional equipment of \$15,486.00 for a total bid of \$218,092.00, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. That there is hereby appropriated from the Fire Truck Fund an additional amount as follows:

SECTION 3. That there is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund an additional amount transferred as follows:

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to protect the lives of Village residents: wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
