

RESOLUTION NO. 12-1995

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE RESURFACING OF TWO TENNIS COURTS WITH AN ALTERNATE BID FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF TWO TENNIS COURTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Park Board has recommended the resurfacing of two tennis courts; and

WHEREAS, if sufficient monies are available, including the possibility of State grant, the Park Board has additionally recommended the reconstruction of two tennis courts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the resurfacing of two tennis courts with an alternate bid of reconstruction of two tennis courts with this Council reserving the option to resurface two tennis courts, resurface two tennis courts and reconstruct two tennis courts or reject all bids in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file in the office of the Service Director.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to have the work on the tennis courts performed as soon as possible in the spring season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
