

RESOLUTION NO. 6 -2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE A NEW VEHICLE FOR THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT FROM MONTROSE AUTO GROUP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to purchase a 2014 Transit Connect XLT Wagon for the Recreation Department from Montrose Auto Group.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized and directed to purchase a Transit Connect XLT Wagon for the Recreation Department from Montrose Auto Group for a total amount not to exceed \$25,000.00.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to acquire the new vehicle to facilitate the recreational services at the earliest possible time and because the dealer of the vehicle has only one vehicle available for immediate delivery; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
