

RESOLUTION NO. 19-1995

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR A NEW TRUCK AS A SERVICE TRUCK FOR SEWERS FOR THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS NOW ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE SERVICE DIRECTOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for a new truck as a service truck for sewers for the Service Department in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file in the office of the Service Director.
- SECTION 2. The acceptance of the bids shall be governed by Ordinance 25-1994.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the truck is immediately necessary to service the Village's sewers; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
