

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF AEROMARK, INC. FOR STREET STRIPING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, bids were received for striping of Village streets in accordance with plans and specifications prepared by the Service Director; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Aeromark, Inc. in the amount of \$10,426.36 has been recommended by the Service Director as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the bid of Aeromark, Inc. in the amount of \$10,426.36 for street striping, being the lowest and best bid, be, and the same hereby is, accepted.

SECTION 2. That this Council finds that the intent, if not the technical procedure, of Ordinance No. 25-1994 has been complied with.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provide for traffic safety; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution of the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
