

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF UP TO, AND NOT TO EXCEED, \$5,700.00 FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE HISTORIC VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD FIRE TRUCK TOGETHER WITH THE PAD AND OPEN-AIR PAVILION TO BE LOCATED TO THE REAR OF TOWN HALL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, several members of the Richfield Fire Department have proposed a project to restore the historic Richfield fire truck; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes that this project is a commendable project which will honor the Village's long-standing commitment to fire safety and to provide first class fire fighter services for the citizens of the Village of Richfield; and

WHEREAS, to further these proper public purposes, this Council wishes to commit to paying for up to, and not to exceed, \$5,700.00 for the restoration of the historic fire truck together with the pad and open-air pavilion.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council does hereby go on record as committing to pay for up to, and not to exceed, \$5,700.00 for the restoration of the historic fire truck to be rehabilitated by the members of Richfield Fire Department together with the pad and open-air pavilion. When rehabilitated, this truck shall be on display for view of all of the citizens of Richfield in back of the Town Hall.

SECTION 2. Payments for the restoration shall be subject to members of the Fire Department providing estimates to the Finance Director for approval and appropriation of funds by Council and commitment by others to provide funds for the remainder of the restoration.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
