

A RESOLUTION TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1995

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. To provide for other expenditures of the said Village of Richfield during the year ending December 31, 1995, the following sums be, and they hereby are, set aside and appropriated as follows:

SECTION 8. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village for payments for any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board of officers authorized

by law to approve the same, or an Ordinance or Resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with the law or Ordinance.
