A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR A FIRE PUMPER/RESCUE UNIT AND EQUIPMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SPECIFICATIONS NOW ON FILE WITH THE FIRE CHIEF TO REPLACE FIRE PUMPER/RESCUE UNIT 3014 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for a Fire Pumper/Rescue unit and equipment in accordance with the specifications now on file with the Fire Chief to replace Fire Pumper/Rescue 3014.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order for the efficient operation of the Fire Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


