

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 945.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES WITH RESPECT TO RATES AND CHARGES FOR CEMETERY LOTS AND TO REPEAL EXISTING SECTION 945.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the rates and charges for cemetery lots were last amended in 1986 by Ordinance No. 13-1986; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has recommended upgrading of rates and charges for cemetery lots and related services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 945.01 of the Codified Ordinances be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

**"945.01 RATES AND CHARGES.**

Effective January 1, 1996, the following rates and charges shall be applicable to cemeteries operation by the Village of Richfield:

(a)	Each cemetery lot - Village residents	\$325.00
(b)	Each cemetery lot - non-residents	450.00
(c)	Interment of ashes - Village residents	100.00
(d)	Interment of ashes - non-residents	150.00
(e)	Interment - Village residents	335.00
(f)	Interment - non-residents	375.00
(g)	Infant burials in family lot	130.00
(h)	Late burials after 3:00 p.m. - additional	50.00
(i)	Saturday burials - additional	100.00
(j)	Monument bases - per square foot	35.00
(k)	Exhumation	500.00
(l)	Mausoleum crypt - Village residents	1,400.00
(m)	Mausoleum crypt - non-residents	1,525.00
(n)	Mausoleum cremation niche - Village residents	300.00
(o)	Mausoleum cremation niche - non-residents	350.00
(p)	Mausoleum interment - Village residents	200.00
(q)	Mausoleum interment - non-residents	325.00
(r)	Mausoleum cremation interment - Village residents	100.00
(s)	Mausoleum cremation interment - non-residents	150.00
(t)	Mausoleum plaques - list price from supplier plus 10%"	

SECTION 2. The Director of Public Service shall require, as a prior condition to the provision of the service provided pursuant to Section 1 hereof, except for division (j), payment in full.

SECTION 3. That existing Section 945.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Richfield be, and the same hereby is, repealed.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
