

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND  
DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH  
SUMMIT COUNTY PUBLIC DEFENDER COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO  
REPRESENTATION OF INDIGENT PERSONS FOR THE YEARS 1996 AND  
1997 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit  
County, Ohio

Section 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized  
and directed to enter into a contract for legal  
services with the Summit County Defender Commission  
for the Years 1996 and 1997.

Section 2: The form of the contract, now on file in the office  
of the Director of Public Service, is hereby  
approved.

Section 3: Council finds and determines the agreement is for  
personal services which do not require competitive  
bidding.

Section 4: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed  
to draw on the appropriate account of this Village  
for payment of such services.


Section 5: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency  
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of  
the public peace, health, or safety for the reason  
to provide indigent services and provided this  
Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-  
thirds of the members elected or appointed, it  
shall take effect and be in force from and after  
its approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take  
effect and be in force from and after the earliest  
date provided by law.
