

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE TWO (2) POLICE SUVs, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield is a member of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program; and


WHEREAS, the Village wishes to purchase two (2) 2014 Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicles for the Police Department from Valley Ford Truck for a price substantially less than the price under the State Purchasing Program from Valley Ford Truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase two new police vehicles from Valley Ford Truck, for a total amount not to exceed \$50,200.00.
- SECTION 2. That because the price for these two (2) vehicles under the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services State Purchasing Program would be \$68,470.00, this Council waives the requirement for competitive bidding.
- SECTION 3. That the Finance Director is authorized and directed to appropriate from the Capital Improvements, Capital Equipment Fund \$50,200.00 for the purchase set forth in Section 1 of this resolution.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to acquire new vehicles to facilitate the acquisition of police vehicles, at substantial savings, at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


