

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO APPLY FOR THE 2014 SURFACE WATER IMPROVEMENT FUND GRANT FROM THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE VILLAGE GREEN PHASE I PARKING LOT IMPROVEMENT AND STORMWATER CONTROL PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) has created the 2014 Surface Water Improvement Fund (SWIF) Grant for grants up to \$150,000 for implementation of projects that address nonpoint source pollution and/or stormwater runoff and improve water quality in Ohio's streams, rivers and lakes; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Village to apply for a SWIF Grant for grant funds for the Village Green Phase I Parking Lot Improvement and Stormwater Control Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council authorizes the Village to apply to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency for funding under its 2014 Surface Water Improvement Fund Grant program for grant funds for the Village Green Phase I Parking Lot Improvement and Stormwater Control Project.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to timely apply for the Grant, which deadline is April 11, 2014, and receive the funding at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


