

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR THE EXCHANGE OF EMS AND/OR FIRE FIGHTING APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT WITH THE CODE 10 WESTSIDE GROUP, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council desires to authorize the Mayor and Finance Director to enter into a mutual aid agreement for the exchange of EMS and/or Fire Fighting Apparatus and Equipment with other members of the Code 10 Westside Group consortium, consisting of the Village of Richfield, the Cities of Norton and Fairlawn, the Townships of Copley, Bath, Chippewa, Granger, and Sharon, and the Valley Fire District.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement for the Exchange of EMS and/or Fire Fighting Apparatus and Equipment with the Code 10 Westside Group, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order make available the exchange of emergency response apparatus and equipment for the safety of Village's citizens, businesses, and visitors; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
