

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TREES FOR THE FALL PLANTING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 29-1994, this Council authorized application to the State of Ohio for funds for the planting of trees; and

WHEREAS, this application has been granted; and

WHEREAS, the Tree Commission has developed a recommendation for the purchase of trees for the fall planting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Service Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for purchase of trees for the fall planting in accordance with the recommendations of the Tree Commission.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it must go into effect immediate so that trees can be purchased for the fall planting; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
