

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN
APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, OHIO TO
THE SUMMIT COUNTY DISTRICT 8 INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE FOR
STATE ISSUE 2 ASSISTANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS: The Village of Richfield has received notification of the availability of funds for capital improvement projects pursuant to Chapter 164 of the Ohio Revised Code, and

WHEREAS: The Village of Richfield had committed local funds and investigated all other available sources of funding and has had plans and specifications prepared for the requested projects, and

WHEREAS: The Summit County District 8 Infrastructure Committee is now accepting applications for Program Year 7 for funding requests through the State Infrastructure Bond Program and the Village of Richfield hereby requests funding approval, and

WHEREAS: The application deadline for District 8 was January 26, 1993.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is authorized and directed to file an application on behalf of the Village of Richfield with the Summit County District 8 Infrastructure Committee for funds for Infrastructure for:

- 1) Brecksville Road Resurfacing and Traffic Signal Replacement.
- 2) Brecksville Road Curbs, Gutters, and Storm Drainage Replacement Engineering.


SECTION 2: The Village of Richfield hereby agrees to abide by all rules and regulations of the Program with its funding requirements, and hereby commits to continual progress toward implementation of these improvement projects.


