


AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH OHIO BELL COMMUNICATIONS, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF UPGRADED EQUIPMENT AND OPERATING SYSTEMS AND MAINTENANCE RENEWAL OF AUTOMATIC NUMBER IDENTIFICATION HARDWARE FOR THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES (911), TO DETERMINE NO BIDDING IS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:


- SECTION 1:** The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Ohio Bell Communications, Inc., for the purchase and maintenance of certain hardware, to wit, automatic number identification equipment which will provide information for emergency services.
- SECTION 2:** The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized to draw warrants on the proper account of this Village in order to pay for the hardware described in attachments hereto, and maintenance plan per Service Agreement hereto, but not more than the total sum of \$40,472.00.
- SECTION 3:** The form of the contract, now on file in the office of the Director of Public service, is hereby approved.
- SECTION 4:** Council finds and determines that the purchase acquisition, installation and maintenance of such hardware involves customer premises equipment and associated telephone network equipment to be located at a public safety answering point, to wit, this Village of Richfield and made in compliance with a final agreement pursuant to R.C. 4931.48 and that no advertisement or bid or bids is required pursuant to R.C. 4931.41(F).

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to help provide urgently needed emergency services appropriate best wishes and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.


