

RESOLUTION NO. 28-1993

OFFERED BY MAYOR & ALL OF COUNCIL

A Resolution proclaiming the week of May 9-15, 1993, as National Police Officer's Memorial Week and May 12, 1993, as Summit County Peace Officer's Memorial Day in the county of Summit, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, President John F. Kennedy signed into law April 10, 1962, Public Law 87-54, proclaiming that May 12th be declared "*Peace Officers Memorial Day*" and that the week each year containing May 15th be proclaimed "*National Police Week*" and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield wishes to honor America's Peace Officers who have made the supreme sacrifice while carrying out their duties to our Nation and its communities; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield recognizes the dedication and sacrifice the Peace Officers of this Country make for the protection and well being of all our citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Peace Officers of Richfield Village will join Officers from across our great Nation to honor their fallen brothers and sisters on May 9-15th;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Village of Richfield commemorates the sacrifice of America's Peace Officers by declaring *Wednesday, May 12, 1993*, as *Richfield Village Peace Officer's Memorial Day* when all Summit County Government flags shall be flown at half staff in their honor.

SECTION 2: The Village of Richfield proclaims the week of May 9 - 15, 1993 as *National Police Officer's Memorial Week* in the Village of Richfield, Ohio.

SECTION 3: The Clerk of Council shall forward **certified copies** of this Resolution to all Law Enforcement Agencies within the Village and to the State Lodge, Fraternal Order of Police of Ohio in Columbus, Ohio.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
