


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE SUMMIT/AKRON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY (d/b/a REWORKS) FOR A COMMUNITY RECYCLING ACCESS GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


WHEREAS, this Council wishes to authorize the Mayor and the Finance Director to submit an application for the Community Recycling Access Grant from the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority (d/b/a Reworks), in order to sustain and increase recycling in the Village, which grant money shall be applied toward the recycling portion of the Village contract with Rumpke of Northern Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:


- SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to submit an application for the 2014 Community Recycling Access Grant from the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority for grant monies to apply towards the Village's recycling portion of its current contract with Rumpke of Northern Ohio.
- SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to send Reworks a copy of this Resolution to the attention of Jenny Markovich, Program Coordinator, Reworks, 12 East Exchange Street, Third Floor, Akron, Ohio 44308.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to submit the application for said grant as close as possible to the application deadline of April 13, 2014; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
