

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC CODE TO CONFORM TO STATE LAW CHANGES AS ENACTED BY THE OHIO GENERAL ASSEMBLY. *& Declaring an Emergency.*

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly has revised certain traffic provisions of State law relative to the penalty for DUI and licensing vehicle operators; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial and advantageous for the Village of Richfield to revise its legislation accordingly so as to be compatible with the State law changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Council hereby approves the adoption of the August 1993 Replacement Pages to Part 3 - Traffic Code of the Richfield Codified Ordinances, and also approves changes to Sections 333.99, 335.05, 335.07 and 335.99, to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly and to provide for more effective law enforcement.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Richfield Village, Ohio, for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the August 1993 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances to the officials and residents of the Village, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
