

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE GLENCAIRN CORPORATION TO PROVIDE WATER AND SEWER SERVICES TO PROPERTY OWNED BY THE GLENCAIRN CORPORATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Glencairn Corporation to provide water and sewer utilities to property owned by the Glencairn Corporation both in the Village of Richfield and in Richfield Township, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. That, as reflected in the attached agreement, the Village hereby waives its policy not to provide sanitary sewer utilities to properties outside of the Village boundaries only to the extent that sanitary sewer utilities may be provided to the property owned by the Glencairn Corporation in Richfield Township.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the provision of water and sewer utilities to the property owned by the Glencairn Corporation is immediately necessary to insure the development of Glencairn's properties and to assure appropriate development of properties in the Village; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect

and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
