

RESOLUTION NO. 64-1993

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A UTILITY TRUCK ON AN EXISTING CHASSIS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Service Director is authorized to advertise for bids and the Mayor and Finance Director are authorized to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder for the purpose of constructing a utility truck on an existing chassis in the Fire Department in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Fire Chief, which plans and specifications are hereby approved.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the utility truck is necessary at the earliest possible time for the efficient operation of the Fire Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


