

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FORMATION OF A REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY, PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 343.011, FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXECUTING ALL THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE SOLID WASTE LAWS OF OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the County must comply with the solid waste laws of Ohio (House Bill 592); and

WHEREAS, the County has formed a Solid Waste District to meet the initial requirements of House Bill 592; and

WHEREAS, under the solid waste laws of Ohio, specifically Ohio Revised Code Section 343.011, a County may, upon its own initiative or at the request of the legislative authority of any municipal corporation or township located in the District, adopt a Resolution proposing the formation of a regional solid waste management authority; and

WHEREAS, the County has, through its Solid Waste District, received two requests from municipal corporations, Barberton and Cuyahoga Falls, to propose the formation of an Authority; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit, through Resolution 92-314, dated May 4, 1992, has proposed the formation of a Regional Solid Waste Authority and has requested that each Legislative Authority vote on the question of a Regional Solid Waste Management Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Richfield desires to join with other Summit County communities in support of the formation of a Regional Solid Waste Management Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. This Council does hereby declare its approval of the creation of a Solid Waste Management District as proposed by County of Summit Resolution 92-314.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in order to expedite a vote on the question and for a timely determination of whether an authority shall be formed in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Richfield Village, County of Summit; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of

five members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
