**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO PURCHASE TWO (2) NEW POLICE CRUISERS WITH ALTERNATE FOR TRADE IN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:


**SECTION 1:** That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids and the Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of two (2) new Police cruisers with alternate bid for trade in, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Director of Public Service.

**SECTION 2:** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to advertise for the continued operation of the Police Department and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
