

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE REVERE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND ISSUE #57, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The Revere Local School District Board of Education has placed Bond Issue #57 on the Ballot of November 3, 1992, and

WHEREAS: Issue #57 will generate sufficient funds to provide for relief from overcrowded conditions at Hillcrest Primary, the Middle School, and Revere High School in the form of additions and renovations to the existing buildings, and

WHEREAS: An excellent education is the most significant gift that we can pass on to our children and Issue #57 is essential to our ability to provide that gift.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Mayor and Council of The Village of Richfield, Ohio

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Council appeal to the citizens of our community to actively support passage of Issue #57.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and Council of the Village of Richfield unanimously endorse and support this plea for the support of our Revere Local School District Board of Education.
