

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PURCHASE A 1993 THREE-QUARTER TON, FOUR-WHEEL DRIVE PICK UP TRUCK THROUGH THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 50-1988, the Village of Richfield entered into the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Department of Administrative Services of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has informed Council that the Village is in need of a new three-quarter ton, four-wheel drive pick up truck; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Purchasing Program has determined that such a truck would be available from 32 Ford-Mercury, Inc., 610 West Main Street, Batavia, Ohio 45103 at a cost of \$15,087.00 which the Service Director believes is fair and reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase a new 1993 three-quarter ton, four-wheel drive pick up truck from 32 Ford-Mercury, Inc., 610 West Main Street, Batavia, Ohio 45103, at a cost of \$15,087 through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services' State Cooperative Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the pick up truck is immediately necessary for the functioning of the Service Department; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and

execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
