

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SUMMIT COUNTY SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Village is responsible for carrying out the mandated responsibilities inherent in the NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) Phase II Storm Water Permit;

WHEREAS, the Village recognizes the need for effective collaboration with other communities to successfully implement water quality education programs for its citizens;

WHEREAS, the Summit County Soil and Water Conservation District ("Summit SWCD") has the technical and educational expertise and staff to assist communities with such cooperation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the community to work with the Summit SWCD to assist the community and to reasonably cooperate with Summit SWCD to this end.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the Mayor and the Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Summit County Soil and Water Conservation District, substantially in accordance with the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully by reference.
- SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
