

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 171.03 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR'S COURT TO IMPOSE A FEE NOT TO EXCEED \$10.00 FOR EACH CASE TO BE USED FOR THE COMPUTERIZATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF COURT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 171.03 of the Administrative Code be enacted to read as follows:

"171.03 COSTS.

In addition to all other costs, the Mayor's Court is authorized to impose an additional fee and cost not to exceed Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each case filed which funds shall be used for the computerization of the office of clerk of court.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to provide efficiency in the clerk's office; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
