

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING SECTION 123.02 OF THE RICHFIELD CODE CONCERNING PUBLISHING OF ENACTMENTS OF COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 123.02 of the Administrative Code be enacted to read as follows:

"123.02 PUBLISHING OF ENACTMENTS OF COUNCIL.

Council finds that in the Village of Richfield no newspaper is printed, as defined in Ohio Revised Code Section 7.12, and it determines that all ordinances, resolutions, statements, orders, proclamations, notices and reports required by law or ordinance to be published shall be published by posting copies thereof in not less than six (6) of the most public places in the Village, as defined in Section 123.01 of the Administrative Code, for a period of not less than fifteen days."

SECTION 2: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary in order to clarify legislative procedures; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
