

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ANNEXATION OF APPROXIMATELY
105 ACRES IN RICHFIELD TOWNSHIP TO THE VILLAGE OF
RICHFIELD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on January 8, 1991, the Clerk of Council received the order of the Summit County Council together with related documentation ("the Order") relating to the annexation of approximately 105 acres in Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.04, sixty (60) days has expired from the date of filing of the Order with the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 1991, the Clerk of Council laid the Order, transcript and accompanying map or plat and petition required by Section 709.033 of the Ohio Revised Code before this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the application for annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. That this Council does hereby accept the application for annexation of approximately 105 acres in Richfield Township to the Village of Richfield.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.06, the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to make three (3) certified copies of this Ordinance together with the petition, the map accompanying the petition and a transcript of the proceedings of the Summit County Council and all other resolutions and ordinances relating to the annexation and deliver one (1) such copy to the County Auditor; one (1) such copy to the County Recorder with a request that he make a record thereof in the proper book of records and file and preserve it; and the other copy shall be forwarded to the Secretary of State.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the annexation is immediately necessary to effectuate an agreement between the Village of Richfield and Richfield Township;

wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
