

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ELEWSKI & ASSOCIATES FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES WITH RESPECT TO THE BRECKSVILLE ROAD WATER LINE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and Finance Director be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Elewski & Associates for professional engineering services with respect to the Brecksville Road Water Line, a copy of which contract is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to commence design of the project; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Dear Mayor:

Per your request, we are respectfully submitting to you our Preliminary Engineer's Estimate of Cost for construction of a water main for the Brecksville Road Water Main Extension along with our engineering fees for the plans and specifications for the project.

Costs were derived from current water main construction costs and City of Cleveland Water Department design practice. The project requires a 16" water main to be installed from Brush Road southerly to the south village line (Everett Rd.), a 12" water main provided for Congress Parkway and Wheatley Road, and 8" stubs for the residential streets; Hawthorne Drive, Maple Drive, Muriel Drive and Hart Road.

The engineering and surveying services shall include preparation of plans, profiles, details, specifications, bid proposal and attending City of Cleveland Water Department meetings.

Easements and assessment calculations are not part of this proposal.




