

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHFIELD WITH RESPECT TO PROVIDING A SAFETY TOWN PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with the Township of Richfield with respect to a Safety Town Program.


SECTION 2: The form of the contract, now on file in the Office of the Director of Public Service, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, helath, or safety for the reason to provide authority for contract action, and, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
