RESOLUTION NO.69 -2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO APPLY FOR A SAFETY GRANT FROM THE BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT ACCEPTING THE TERMS OF THE GRANT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation has created the Safety Grant program intended to provide grant funds to defray costs incurred by employers for projects that substantially reduce or eliminate the risk of work place injuries and illness; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Village to apply for the Safety Grant for funds to offset the cost of purchase and installation of a Power Loader and Power Cot for the Village's Fire Department and further desires to authorize the Mayor and the Finance Director to appropriate the funds and execute the proposed grant agreement, accepting the terms of the grant if such is awarded to the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

- Section 1. That this Council authorizes the application to the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation's Safety Grant program for grant funds to offset the cost of purchase and installation of a Power Loader and Power Cot for the Village Fire Department.
- Section 2. That there be appropriated from the FIRE EQUIPMENT FUND – Capital Equipment \$44,314.00.
- Section 3. That the Mayor and the Finance Director are authorized to execute the proposed grant agreement, accepting the terms of the grant if such is awarded to the Village.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to timely apply for the grant and receive the funding at the earliest possible time; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council


